“I definitely watch the offense. I wasn’t a big time Panthers fan though, so I wasn’t always going for the panthers or watching them so it’s a little different because I was actually born in Virginia, so I didn’t grow up a Panthers fan.”

### **On what stands out to him about the Washington offense:**

“For me, it’s to be effective in the run and the pass game. It’s a lot that goes on in the offense so it’s not to just key in on a run or a pass, there’s both that goes in the game. Just me coming in ready to compete and be competitive in both the pass and run game is something I expect to expand on.”

### **On if speed is his best asset:**

“I feel like a whole lot of my game hasn’t been shown throughout the past few years just because of how our offense was, I feel like I’m an all-around receiver that can do it all. Speed isn’t the only thing that I can do.”

### **On his dynamic with North Carolina QB Sam Howell:**

“The first year, he just came in as a freshman and played, so I knew he was my quarterback. He’s actually from Charlotte, so we could meet up in the offseason, run routes, get the chemistry done. I think for this past season for us to do it again, COVID and quarantine helped us because we could always link up. Being with him all the time during that quarantine time when COVID first hit, it just helped a lot. Just being with him, it helped both of us out.”
