



WASHINGTON COMMANDERS TRAINING CAMP PRACTICE AT FEDEXFIELD ACTIVATIONS AND MEDIA OPPORTUNITIES

WHAT:

The Washington Commanders will host a Training Camp Practice Event at FedExField on Saturday, August 6. Parking lots will open at 2 p.m., gates open at 4:30 p.m., and the main practice event will kick off at 6:45 p.m., concluding at 9:45 p.m. Upon gates opening, the event will feature a series of activations including meet and greets with Washington Legends and the Command Force team members located outside the Touchdown Club, as well as the Aquafina kid zone located in the Pepsi End Zone with face painting and arts and crafts. From 4:30 to 6:30 p.m., all Season Ticket Members will have the opportunity to experience Taste of FedExField on the club level, which includes a sampling of new concession items that will be available this season. Additionally, the team is excited to unveil select artwork pieces from the inaugural Command the Canvas initiative. Artwork can be found in the East End Zone on the concourse from sections 130 to 134 and ramps throughout the concourse. Additional artwork will be unveiled at the preseason game against the Carolina Panthers on Saturday, August 13 and the home opener against the Jacksonville Jaguars on Sunday, September 11.

Headlining the concourse activations, there will be a Pet Adoption Event located in the East End Zone, on the concourse from sections 130 to 134 from 4:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. Approximately 30 dogs will be up for adoption from the following area non-profit agencies specializing in pet adoption: [Wolf Trap Animal Rescue](#), [Homeward Trails Animal Rescue](#), and [Friends of Homeless Animals](#). To conclude the Pet Adoption Event, there will be a presentation check ceremony on behalf of the Washington Commanders Charitable Foundation to the three animal rescue agencies in the amount of \$15,000 total (\$5,000 each).

Beginning at 6:45 p.m., fans will have the opportunity to watch a fully padded practice. During breaks, the Command Force and the Commanders Marching Band will perform and provide live entertainment.
