

## REGULAR SEASON - WEEK 8 WASHINGTON COMMANDERS AT KANSAS CITY CHIEFS

## **COMMANDERS-CHIEFS POSTGAME NOTES**

- The Washington Commanders fell to the Kansas City Chiefs 28-7 on Monday night.
- **Washington** held Kansas City scoreless in the first quarter. It is the first time since Week 10 of last season that the Chiefs have been held scoreless in the first quarter.
- **Washington** recorded two interceptions in the first half for first time since Week 7 of the 2024 season against the Carolina Panthers.
- **Washington** intercepted Chiefs QB Patrick Mahomes twice in the first half. It was the first time Mahomes has been picked twice in a first half since Week 4, 2023. It was also the first time in Mahomes' career he has been picked off in his first two drives of a game.
- Washington had zero first half penalties for the first time since Week 4 of the 2024 season.
- **Washington** allowed the fewest points in a half this season since allowing three in the first half of the Week 1 game against the New York Giants.
- **Washington** held Kansas City to seven points in the first half. It is the second-fewest points the Chiefs have scored in the first half of a game this season. It is the fewest points they have scored in the first half of a game at home since Week 16 of the 2023 season.
- **QB Marcus Mariota** completed 21-of-30 passes for 230 yards, one touchdown and two interceptions. He added eight rushes for 28 yards on the ground.
- **Mariota** had 155 passing yards in the first half. It is the most passing yards in a first half by Mariota since Week 3, 2022.
- **TE John Bates** recorded one reception for 22 yards, which is his longest reception since Week 2, 2023.
- TE Zach Ertz totaled four receptions for 16 yards.
- **Ertz** recorded his 800<sup>th</sup> reception and has become the sixth tight end in NFL history with 800 career receptions. He joins Tony Gonzalez, Jason Witten, Travis Kelce, Antonio Gates and Shannon Sharpe.
- WR Terry McLaurin had three receptions for 54 yards and one touchdown.
- **McLaurin** recorded his first touchdown reception of the season and his first touchdown reception of the regular season since Week 18 of the 2024 season.

- **McLaurin** (6,582) has passed WR Art Monk (6,550) for the most receiving yards in a player's first seven seasons in franchise history.
- **RB Jeremy McNichols** recorded one carry for four yards along with five receptions for 64 yards. McNichols' 64 receiving yards led the team.
- McNichols' 24-yard reception was his longest reception since Week 5, 2021.
- **McNichols** has reached 12 receptions this season which has surpassed his reception total for last season (9).
- **TE Ben Sinnott** recorded one reception for 22 yards. The second quarter reception was the longest of his career.
- CB Marshon Lattimore had one interception and one pass defended.
- **Lattimore** recorded his first interception since Week 1 of the 2023 season. It was Mahomes' third interception of the season.
- **DE Jacob Martin** recorded 2.0 sacks and three quarterback hits. Martin has now reached 3.5 sacks this season which has surpassed his sack total for last season (3.0).
- **Martin** also set a new single game career-high with 2.0 sacks.
- S Quan Martin led the team with 14 total tackles, a new single game career-high.
- S Jeremy Reaves totaled six tackles, including two tackles for loss. It was his first career game with multiple tackles for loss.
- LB Bobby Wagner had 10 total tackles, one interception and one pass defended.
- Wagner's interception was his first since Week 16, 2022.
- **P Tress Way** has played in his 187<sup>th</sup> career game which is tied with Chris Hanburger for 7th most games played in franchise history (187).
- **Way** has now reached 800 career punts. He is the second player in franchise history to have at least 800 career punts. First being Mike Bragg (896).
- **Way** becomes the 53*rd* player in NFL history to record 800-plus career punts. He joins Johnny Hecker, Thomas Morstead and Bryan Anger as the only active NFL players to record 800-plus punts.
