### **On being at the New England Patriots facility:**

“It feels good to be here. Be familiar. See the fans. It's bittersweet. There are so many memories here, but at the same time, I'm loving where I'm at.”

### **On breaking up a pass in the end zone and the discussion after:**

“Yeah. You expect that. I'm the villain now, so it's a great feeling to come in here and make plays. It's all love. Me and New England are always and forever, but it's just good to come here and compete emotionally.”

### **On whether it's tough being back in New England:**

“No. I think it's just meeting everybody, seeing everybody seeing the familiar faces. Even the staff, the support staff in the building. Just a lot of emotions and memories that you go and it's just great to see everybody.”

### **On whom he was looking forward to practicing with:**

“Man, everybody. I mean, some of my OGs, Devin, Pat, you see those guys. Like I said, the support staff, you know, people who helped me for nine years, to be the player that I was here. It's, you just enjoy seeing them.”

### **On the disagreements between players during practice:**

“We come to battle. We come to battle. You want to always support your teammates. That's the energy we love to bring. There's an edge and there's a fine line between stepping over the edge, but coming with it, and so we always want to walk that line.”
