## **QB Jayden Daniels**

### **On having WR Terry McLaurin back:**

“I mean, I told y'all he was coming back soon, so I'm excited.”

### **On if the offense feels different with McLaurin and WR Noah Brown:**

“I mean, I would say so. I mean, it's great to have those two back.”

### **On the important things to work on before Week 1:**

“Getting reps, that's the only thing we could really go with now. We didn't have a whole camp, so again, as many reps as possible.”

### **On if he will stay late with McLaurin and Brown:**

“Whatever we need to do to get ready for week one.”

### **On having McLaurin's back during his negotiation process:**

“I mean, it's bigger than ball. Obviously, he's earned that, and you want to have people's back who earn stuff, especially in this league. So, he put in the work, day in and day out, year in and year out. So, he was very deserving of getting paid.”

### **On WR Jaylin Lane:**

“I would just say just his willingness to learn, and he continues to get better each and every day over time from OTAs to now you can see the progression. So, it is more so just finding a routine and trying to navigate and learn as much as you can throughout the rookie year.”

### **On him and McLaurin already being on the same page again:**

“I don't think it ever leaves, so yeah.”

### **On building off the success of last season:**

“I mean, more so just getting on the same page even more. I think that's just how everything works with the chemistry. Another year of growth, another year in the system, the same system. So, you get to learn a little bit more each and every year.”

### **On where the offense can grow this season:**

“I mean, I don't really have expectations. I just think we want to go out there, go out and execute at a high level, as high as we can. So, I don't really put expectations, but I hold ourselves to a high standard of execution.”

### **On T Laremy Tunsil:**

“Very quiet, but also a smooth dude. That's how I describe him, but I'm happy we traded for him. So, it puts a smile on my face.”

**On his relationship with McLaurin:**

“I mean, I don't know, I think it's just two people just getting along. I would say I'm very easygoing, very relatable and I like to have fun, and a lot of people like to have that. So, obviously especially on the football field, just going out there and just showing the work, the type of person we are on and off the field. And I would say probably the main thing is both our faith.”

**On his confidence in McLaurin tracking deep throws:**

“I think it showed last year. I don't think that changes, so same amount of trust.”

**On if he ever thought he'd have this kind of impact on a community:**

“Nah, I can't even lie. Nah, I did not.”

**On his impact on the community:**

“I would say it's cool, but just the impact I want to leave for sure. I want people to just talk good about me when I'm not around, in the room. Outside of just me being a football player, as a role model and somebody in the community, that's kind of the biggest thing but to have somebody named a baby you have me is kind of crazy.”

**On spreading the ball to all of the offensive weapons:**

“Nah, nah, nah, hey, I tell them all the time, man, I go where the defense allows me to throw the football but I just think it just makes our offense that much more dynamic of having those guys out there. If they want play man, I could pick whoever I want to throw the ball. If they want to go zone and stuff like that, I know we're going to have guys that can find the zones and have catch and run opportunities.”

**On wearing a hoodie today to pay homage to McLaurin:**

“Nah, I've been like this. I'm the same way, hoodie. You see me in a hoodie wearing a hood, no matter the weather. I remember when I was even back home in Arizona, I wore a hoodie in 115-degree weather. So, that's just me.”

**On the value in getting reps with the starting offensive line:**

“I think reps are just valuable in this sport. I mean football you practice more than you play. Other sports you play more than you practice, so just those reps that we get within a week are very valuable. Leading up to Sundays.”

**On how McLaurin being back will impact the other receivers:**

“I mean, Terry's resume speaks for itself, so I don't really have too much to say on that.”

**On his comfort level working with Offensive Coordinator Kliff Kingsbury and if their relationship has changed:**

“Yeah, most definitely just our trust within each other to want to win and obviously put the best product out there but I think that kind of built over more last year. But even this year, like I'll tell him like, I'd rather, I think I'd rather do this than that. He would just go with it because at the end of the day, we both want to win.
