On how he felt watching his Week 1 film:

“I could have played better. That's end of the line. Nothing more to really say, we on to Green Bay now.”

On if Green Bay Packers LB Micah Parsons is the kind of player he has to keep his eye on at the line of scrimmage:

“Yeah, he got paid a lot of money, so I would think for a reason. So, for sure.”

On his thoughts when watching Parsons play:
