"It's up to the doctors, not my decision."

### **On where he's at with his injury:**

"I feel good."

### **On QB Marcus Mariota's performance on Sunday:**

"Super happy for him. He deserves everything and he's been my biggest supporter. So, it was my turn last week to be his."

### **On how he felt after the Green Bay game and on if he knew he was hurt:**

"Nah, I didn't know. I mean, I'm a football player at the end of the day, you might take some shots here and there and it wasn't stopping me from going out there and finishing the game, so I finished the game."

### **On his reaction to Head Coach Dan Quinn telling him he wasn't going to play in Week 3:**

"I'll leave that between me and him. It wasn't the most, 'Okay, yeah, I'm going to sit out.'"

### **On how the injury affects him the most:**

"I mean, I don't know. I feel good, so I don't think it affects me."

### **On potentially not having WR Terry McLaurin this week and on how big of a loss that would be:**
