## **QB Jayden Daniels**

### **On how he looks more comfortable as training camp progresses:**

“Yeah, I think as reps and time goes on and you get more of a grasp in the field for who can run what route, how [OC David] Blough’s supposed to call it and how he wants to call things. This is what practice is for. So, day by day, I just try to come in and have control of the offense and get one percent better.”

### **On how the young guys have made an impression on him:**

“Their willingness and their eagerness to go out there and learn has been very big for their development so far. JB [WR Jaden Bradley], [WR] Antonio [Williams], all those guys that came in just wanting to learn, we’ve all been in it together. So, we’re all learning together. Nobody’s better than anybody else. We’re all just trying to get better each and every day.”

### **On the chemistry picking up over camp:**

“We’re just putting in the work to get there. I wouldn’t say we’re in mid-season form. You wouldn’t want to be in mid-season form right now, but we’re just going day by day, really.”

### **On understanding each receiver and communicating well:**

“I would say it’s a mixture of both. Just having an open communication about how I see routes being ran, who’s good at what, what their strengths, what their weaknesses are. How can I put this type of throw for this specific person and stuff like that. So, you just go out there and have a conversation about that. You put it into full tuition out there on the field.”

### **On T Laremy Tunsil being out due to injury:**

“You can’t replace LT. LT is one of one, but I got confidence in BC [G Brandon Coleman] and next man up mentality. I trust all my teammates to go out there and perform and do their job.”

### **On having WR Stefon Diggs on their team:**

“Man, it’s awesome. Just his feeling for space. He’s a dog. He goes out and makes plays. He brings energy, he’s a leader. So, I’m super happy to have Stefon in that room. Not just for the offense, but just for the whole team in general.”

### **On WR Antonio Williams:**

“It’s been good, man. Like I say, he’s super eager to learn. He’s like a little brother. He’s still a rookie at the end of the day, so we give him a tough time. But we know that he wants to go out there and work and he wants to go out there and perform. He wants to earn the trust and he’s been doing that.”

### **On joint practices compared to preseason games:**

“I think you see - I don't know. I don't know. Football is football to me, so I don't know.”

**On if it's beneficial understanding the pressure in the pocket before he makes the throw:**

“I mean, yes and no. There's only so much I could, I mean, I guess you could do because I'm not live, so some might be sacks that aren't sacks and stuff like that. I'm just trying to work my game. And if they get pressure, you know, work my game, keep my eyes down the field, get the second day better for the other team. Our team, get the receivers ready for scramble drill. When those moments come up in the game, we're prepared.”

**On if he feels like he's just as good as he was two years ago:**

“I felt like this last year, so I wasn't hurt around this time last year. But it's year in, year out. So, it's a new year. I don't wanna compare what I did my first two years. Now I'm in a new season, a new year. So, I'm just trying to be the best version of myself every day.”

**On his comfort level in understanding the offensive concepts and connecting with his teammates:**

“I still got some ways to go, man. We have supposed plays and stuff like that, but live is not perfect. I'm still working. The whole team's still working, you know, still building that chemistry and continuity. So, we still got a long way to go.”

**On working with Quarterbacks Coach D.J. Williams:**

“It's been good, man. He's like a big brother, little brother type of thing. So, you can only imagine what that's like. We butt heads and stuff like that, but he knows all out of love. I know he wants the best for me. He wants the best for everybody in that room. Sometimes you don't see eye to eye, you know, you kind of go back and forth, but at the end of the day, it's all love. So, super grateful to have him in the room.”

**On where he's seen the offense grow the most so far:**

“I would say just our play style. The intentionality that we have that Blough wants for our system. Guys stepping up, being leaders within the huddle. If we're not meeting the standard of breaking the huddle and lining up, getting to the ball with some urgency, somebody else is saying if I'm not saying it. So, that's kind of the biggest thing. And as the days progress, just the intensity, the intentionality of the concepts and stuff like that. Play in and play out, we're trying to get it perfect, but you know you're gonna fail at practice, so.”

**On CB Amik Robertson:**

“Oh, yeah. Meek, man. Man, he's a good player. I ain't gonna lie. He makes it tough. He likes to jump a lot of routes. He's very smart, has a lot of awareness to a lot of things, so he makes me better at making sure I put the ball in the right spot. If not, it's gonna either be a PBU or it might be a pick.”
